- Class 2 Shetland Yearling, open to Colts, Fillies and Geldings
- Class 3 Shetland 2 & 3 Year Old, open to Colts, Fillies and Geldings
- Class 4 Shetland 4 Years & over, open to Stallions, Mares and Geldings
- Class 5 Open Broken Colour Shetland – Open to Miniature and Standard Shetlands of any sex or age.
- Class 6 Open Solid Colour Shetland – Open to Miniature and Standard Shetlands of any sex or age.

Championship (1st & 2nd from classes 1 - 6) **Champion and Reserve to compete in Miniature Horse / Shetland Supreme.**

This section of classes is for Miniature Horses measuring 38” and under at maturity, regardless of any specific registration requirements. Classes are open to ALL types of Miniature Horses unless a dedicated type class. These classes are a qualifier for MHOYS 2021.

- Class 7 New Combination – Miniature Horse / Shetland Pony and Handler never to have competed together prior to this class.
- Class 8 Foal of current year – Miniature Horse, born 2021.
- Class 9 Yearling Miniature Horse, colt, filly or gelding.

Class 10 2 Year Old Miniature Horse, colt, filly or gelding.

Class 11 3 Year Old Miniature Horse, stallion, mare or gelding.

Class 12 4 Years and Over Miniature Horse, stallion, mare or gelding.

Championship (1st & 2nd from classes 8 – 12) **Champion and Reserve to compete in Miniature Horse / Shetland Supreme.**

Class 13 Solid Colour Miniature Horse, any age, any height up to 38”.

Class 14 Broken Colour Miniature Horse, any age, any height up to 38”

Class 15 Alternative Colour Miniature Horse (Palomino, Spotted, Roan, etc), any age, any height up to 38”.

Championship (1st & 2nd from classes 13 – 15) **Champion and Reserve to compete in Miniature Horse / Shetland Supreme.**

Class 16 Scaled Down Hack Type – open to those horses who, if full size would be of a refined, elegant hack type.

Class 17 Scaled Down Riding Horse Type – open to those horses who, if full size would be of a quality middleweight.

Class 18 Scaled Down Hunter Type – open to those horses who, if full size would be of a more substantial quality type with more bone than that of a Riding Horse.

Championship (1st & 2nd from classes 16 – 18) **Champion and Reserve to compete in Miniature Horse / Shetland Supreme.**

Class 19 Miniature Horse or American Shetland registered AMHR or ASPC. Filly, colt, mare, gelding or stallion, any age. Unaffiliated.

Class 20 Miniature Horse registered with the AMHA. Filly, colt, mare, gelding or stallion, any age. Unaffiliated.

- Class 21 Miniature Horse with bloodlines that are 75% British. Filly, colt, mare, gelding or stallion, any age.
- Class 22 Fallabella, pure or part bred. Filly, colt, mare, gelding or stallion, any age.
- Class 23 Part bred Miniature Horse or American Shetland. Must be part bred ASPC, AMHR, AMHA or BMHS.

Championship (1st & 2nd from classes 19 – 23) **Champion and Reserve to compete in Miniature Horse / Shetland Supreme.**

- Class 24 New Combination – Horse/Pony and Handler never to have competed together prior to this class.
- Class 25 Young Handler – Handlers to be 15 years and under.
- Class 26 Mature Handler – Handlers to be 50 years and over.
- Class 27 Veteran Horse or Pony. 15 years and over.
- Class 28 Open Foreign breed, any age, any height.
- Class 29 Part Bred horse or pony, any age.
- Class 30 Open Mountain and Moorland Small Breed, any age.
- Class 31 Open Mountain and Moorland Large Breed, any age.
- Class 32 In hand pony, any age (excluding any M&M breed). Not exceeding 148cm at maturity.
- Class 33 In hand horse, any age (excluding any M&M breed). Exceeding 148cm at maturity.
- Class 34 Yearling horse or pony, colt, filly or gelding.
- Class 35 2 & 3 Year Old horse of pony, colt, filly or gelding.
- Class 36 Open Coloured horse or pony, any age, any height.
- Class 37 Any alternative coloured horse or pony, any age, any height. Not to include Skewbald or Piebald.

Class 38 New Combination – Horse/Pony and Rider never to have competed together prior to this class.

Class 39 Novice Combination – Horse/Pony and Rider not to have won a first prize in any ridden showing class.

Class 40 Novice Lead Rein & First Ridden Mixed, children to be correct age for Lead Rein or First Ridden as below. Will be split of entries suffice.

Class 41 Open Lead Rein – Children not to have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Ponies not to exceed 128cm.

Class 42 Open First Ridden - Children not to have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Ponies not to exceed 128cm.

Championship (1st & 2nd from classes 38 – 42) **Champion and Reserve to compete in Overall Supreme.**

Class 43 Riding Club Horse or Pony. Any age, any height. A small obstacle will be included in this class.

Class 44 Part Bred horse or pony, any age.

Class 45 Mature Rider Class – Riders to be 50 years or over and to be a suitable weight for the horse they ride. This class has been added by popular demand!

- Class 46 Open Ridden Show / Show hunter pony, not exceeding 153cm, riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1 January in the current year.
- Class 47 Open Ridden horse, exceeding 153cm.
- Class 48 Open Junior Ridden Mountain & Moorland. Children not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Class 49 Open Ridden Mountain & Moorland Small Breeds (will be split if entries are sufficient).
- Class 50 Open Ridden Mountain & Moorland Large Breeds (will be split if entries are sufficient).
- Class 51 Coloured horse or pony, any age, any height. (will be split if entries are sufficient)
- Class 52 Any alternative coloured horse or pony, any age, any height. Not to include Skewbald or Piebald.
- Class 53 Open Foreign breed, any height, any age.
- Class 54 Veteran Horse or Pony. 15 years and over.

Championship (1st & 2nd from classes 43 - 54) **Champion and Reserve to compete in the Overall Supreme.**

Miniature Horse of the Year Show

1st, 2nd and 3rd placed horses in classes 1 – 23 are qualifiers for MHOYS 2021, to be held at Onley Equestrian Centre in September.

Equi-Events Rules

1. All competitors take part at their own risk and are expected to exercise due care at all times and obey all notices displayed by the event organisers and by the venue. The event organisers and the venue accept no responsibility for any accidents, loss or damage to any competitors, spectators, animals or property. It is a condition of entry that competitors will hold the organisers blameless and indemnify them against any damage or legal proceedings.
2. No cruelty to animals of any kind will be tolerated, including but not limited to excessive use of the whip. Anyone proven to be acting in a cruel or unsporting manner will be removed from the showground and forfeit all entry fees.
3. **EQUI-EVENTS EXPECT EACH EXHIBITOR TO TAKE PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR NOT SPREADING COVID-19 VIRUS AND OBEYING ALL RULES REGARDING SOCIAL DISTANCING. Failure to do so will result in removal of you and your entire party from the showground.**
 - A. **DO NOT ATTEND THE SHOW IF YOU ARE SHOWING SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19.**
 - B. Track and Trace **MUST** be given on Entry Forms and Vehicle registration number.
 - C. Show officials have made every effort to safeguard everyone attending but attendance at this show is at your own risk.
4. **ABSOLUTELY NO ADDITIONAL ENTRIES OR AMENDMENTS OF ENTRIES AT THE SHOW.**
5. Equi-Events recommends that all exhibitors should have adequate personal sports insurance. All accidents, injuries or falls should be reported to the secretary.
6. Correct secured Skull caps/riding hats conforming to PAS015 or EN1384 or ASTM F1163 04a onwards SNELL E2001, SNELL E2016 AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards must be worn at all times when mounted, with chinstraps from 3 points on the hat fastened. A rider whose hat comes off will be eliminated, a rider whose hat comes undone must stop immediately to fasten the strap, without penalty.
7. Mares with a foal at foot must be at least 4 years old. No foal should be shown until it is at least 3 weeks old.
8. Stallions and Colts competing in Ring 2 must be handled by a person 14 years and over. The stallion or colt must also be displaying a Stallion badge attached to his bridle. Exhibitors must not kneel and remain standing during the entire class.
9. Stallions and Colts competing in Ring 1 must be handled by a person 10 years old and over.
10. If you fall from a horse or dismount during the class you must immediately leave the ring.
11. Equi-Events reserves the right to alter the times of classes or the Judge if necessary without prior notice. Equi-Events reserve the right to refuse entry of persons or animals at their discretion without assigning a reason.
12. Any objections must be made in writing and must be handed to the secretary within 30 minutes of the completion of the relevant class, and accompanied by a £50 fee which will be refunded should the objection be upheld.
13. Unmannerly behaviour towards officials will not be tolerated and may lead to immediate disqualification.

14. No exercising in the rings will be permitted, doing so will result in disqualification, unless permission has been given by an official.
15. NO ENTRY FEE WILL BE REFUNDED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCE UNLESS THE SHOW IS CANCELLED. IF THE SHOW IS POSTPONED, ENTRIES WILL CARRY OVER.
16. Showing canes must not exceed 30" in length unless deemed to be "dress code" for the appropriate class.
17. THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL
18. No dogs are allowed.
19. Animals must not be left tied, unattended to a trailer or horsebox at any time.
